The District 10 Football Tournament will consist of three (3) divisions; each based upon male enrollment. The Champion Team of a region will automatically qualify for the District 10 Football Tournament. All other teams will qualify on an at large basis. In case of a tie for a region championship, the “Tie Breakers” section in the District 10 Athletic Handbook will be used (article XIV) to determine the final rankings.

8 TEAM TOURNAMENT Class A

(Game 101) The highest ranked team in Region 1 (The Home Team) will play an at-large team (The Visiting Team) and will be played on the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A. At-large team to be chosen by the District 10 Football Committee.

(Game 102) Two at-large teams from Class A (Chosen by the District 10 Football Committee) will play on the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A.

(Game 103) The highest ranked team in Region 2A (The Home Team) will play an at-large team (The Visiting Team) and will be played on the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A. At-large team to be chosen by the District 10 Football Committee.

(Game 104) Two at-large teams from Class A (Chosen by the District 10 Football Committee) will play on the 11th playing date. Site and time T.B.A.

(Game 111) The winners of Games 101 and 102 will play on the 12th playing date at a site and time T.B.A. Winner of game 101 will be the home team.

(Game 112) The winners of games 103 and 104 will play on the 12th playing date at a site and time T.B.A. Winner of game 103 will be the home team.

(Game 121) The winners of games 111 and 112 will play for the District 10 Class A Championship on the 13th playing date. The winner of game 111 will be the home team. Site and time T.B.A.

8 TEAM TOURNAMENT Class AA

(Game 201) The highest ranked team in Region 3AA (The Home Team) will play an at-large team (The Visiting Team). This game will be played on the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A.

Game (202) Two (2) at-large teams from class AA, chosen by the District 10 Football Committee, will play on the 11th playing date at a time and site T.B.A.

(Game 203) The highest ranked team in 4AA (The Home Team) will play an at-large Class AA team chosen by the District 10 Football Committee (The visiting team) on the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A.

(Game 204) Two (2) at-large teams from Class AA, chosen by the District 10 Football Committee, will play the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A.

(Game 211) The winners of games 201 and 202 will play on the 12th playing date at a site and time T.B.A. The winner of game 201 will be the home team.

(Game 212) The winners of games 203 and 204 will play on the 12th playing date at a site and time T.B.A. The winner of game 203 will be the home team.

(Game 221) The winners of games 211 and 212 will play for the District 10 Class AA Championship on the 13th playing date. The winner of game 211 will be the home team. Site and time T.B.A.

8 TEAM TOURNAMENT Class AAA 6 or 8 Team Tournament

(Game 301) The highest ranked team in Region 5AAA (The Home Team) will receive a bye or play an at-large team chosen by the District 10 Football Committee on the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A.

(Game 302) Two (2) at-large teams from class AAA, chosen by the District 10 Football Committee, will play on the 11th playing date at a time and site T.B.A

(Game 303) The highest ranked team in 6AAA (The Home Team) will receive a bye or play an at-large Class A chosen by the District 10 Football Committee (The visiting team) on the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A.

(Game 304) Two (2) at-large teams from Class AAA, chosen by the District 10 Football Committee, will play the 11th playing date at a site and time T.B.A.

(Game 311) The winners of games 301 and 302 will play on the 12th playing date at a site and time T.B.A. The winner of game 301 will be the home team.

(Game 312) The winners of games 303 and 304 will play on the 12th playing date at a site and time T.B.A. The winner of game 303 will be the home team.

(Game 321) The winners of games 311 and 312 will play for the District 10 Class AAA Championship on the 13th playing date. The winner of game 311 will be the home team. Site and time T.B.A.

The District 10 Football Committee reserves the right to determine the number of teams entering the 2010 District 10 Football Tournament.

INFORMATION FOR QUALIFYING TEAMS

PIAA District 10 Football

Tournament Regulations and Information for Qualifying Teams

(Please make copies and route to Principal, AD, Head Coach and Band Director)

- **Sites:** The District 10 Football Committee will designate game sites and times for tournament games.
- **Officials:** The District 10 Officials representative will assign game officials.
- **Team Designation:** The team at the top of bracket will be the **HOME** team and will wear **DARK** colored jerseys. The team at the bottom of the bracket will be the **VISITING** team and wear **LIGHT** colored jerseys.
- **Footballs:** Each team will bring THREE (3) footballs to be used on offense. Each team is also to bring towels for drying the balls and ball boys for the sidelines. The Game Official must approve all game balls.
- **Required Information:** Each team will provide the Game Manager **one hour before game time** (1) TEN copies of the team roster listed in numerical order with positions; season record, coaches names, school nickname and colors, (2) TEN copies of starting line-ups and (3) any other information that may be helpful to the game announcer and media.
- **Overtime:** The 10-yard overtime procedure as outlined by the PIAA will be utilized in the case of a tie at the end of regulation play.
- **Pre-Game Schedule:** **1:30PM or 7:30 PM or 1:00 PM or 7:00 PM Start**

- **Tickets:** Tournament Pre-sale tickets sold at schools are \$4.00. All tickets sold at the gate are \$5.00.
- Complimentary Tickets: **Each participating school receives 15 complimentary tickets for each game they play. Please Note that District 10 Regular Season Passes are not Accepted at Playoff Games.**
- Ticket Accounting: **The principal or his/her representative should report to the Game Manager ONE HOUR before game time with their school's ticket accounting.**
- Team communication systems are the sole responsibility of the respective teams.
- Scouts from schools involved in first round games will be admitted free with a letter from the school Principal presented to the Game Manager.
- Radio Broadcasting Fee: **\$100.00 per game for early rounds, \$150 for semi-finals and \$200.00 for finals, payable in advance to PIAA District 10.** Television broadcasting is subject to BID submitted to the District 10 Chairman.
- Tobacco Policy: **The PIAA Board of Directors policy prohibits the use of Tobacco products by participating and non-participating team personnel, including coaches, during any interscholastic athletic contest. The use of tobacco products in the team box, locker rooms, or on the football field is prohibited. The use of tobacco products by spectators are prohibited in facilities designated "TOBACCO FREE".**

**POLICY STATEMENT
FOR MEMBER SCHOOLS
WITH CONDITIONS OF ENTRY INTO
PIAA DISTRICT TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS**

PIAA District member schools are not required to enter a team into PIAA District Ten Championship events. Entry and participation by member schools in the tournaments sponsored by PIAA District Ten are totally voluntary.

Entry of a team or individual competitor by a member school into a PIAA District Ten tournament signifies that the member school **accepts** the conditions and provisions that are inherent with the tournament rules, regulations, and guidelines.

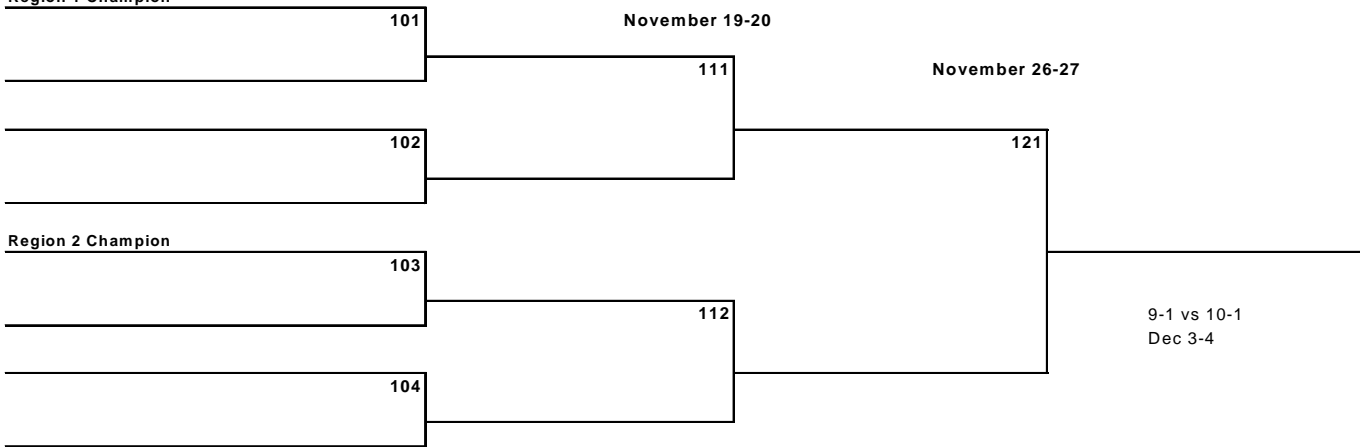

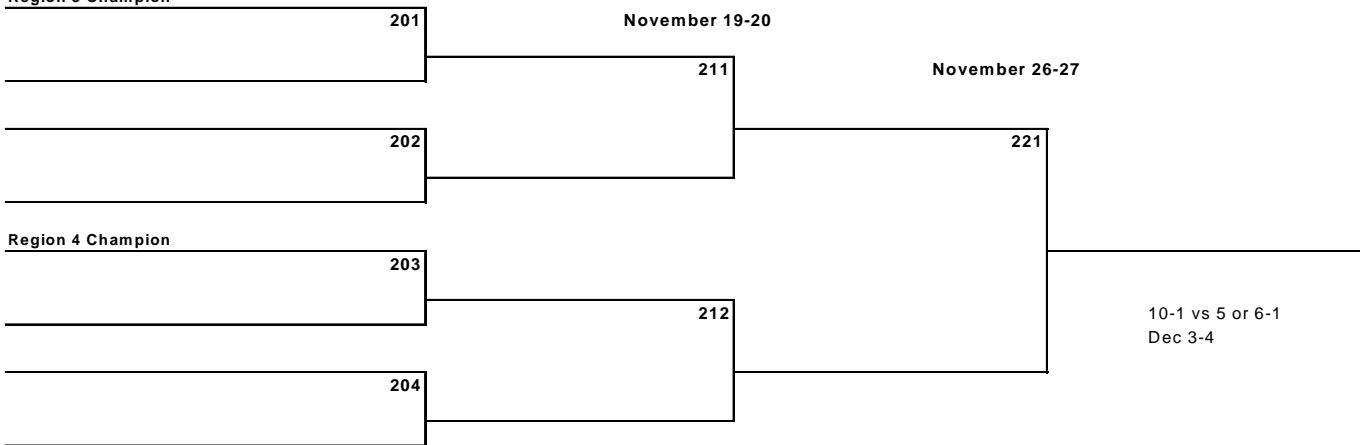
Region 1 Champion

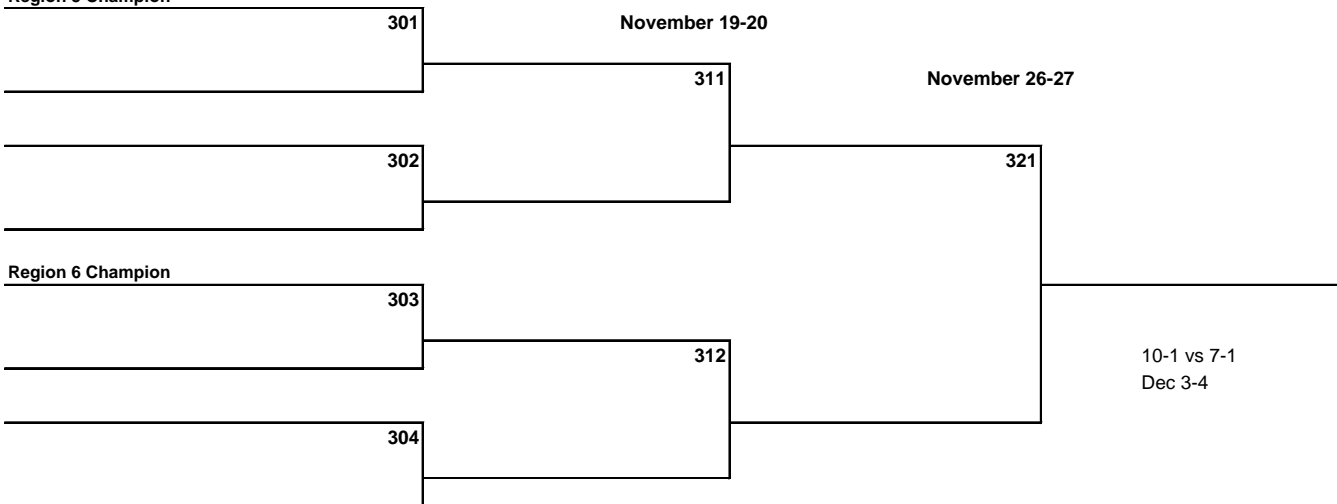
Region 3 Champion
