The following highlights the District Ten meeting of December 2, 2009

### ADMINISTRATION

- ❖ The Committee reluctantly accepted the resignation of Ed Zenewicz as the Junior High Representative. We commend him for his many years of outstanding service.
- ❖ The Committee approved accepting nominations for this position. Any interested parties should submit a brief resume (one page) Consisting of Education, Employment, Athletic experience to the Committee via e-mail to [d10@piaadistrict10.org](mailto:d10@piaadistrict10.org)
- ❖ The Committee voted to accept the termination of a Cooperative Agreement between Hickory High School and Sharpsville in the sport of Girls Soccer.
- ❖ The Committee approved a Co-operative Sports Agreement request between Reynolds and Sharpsville in Girls Golf and Sharpsville and Reynolds in Girls Soccer.
- ❖ The Committee reviewed the report submitted by McDowell High School on procedural changes for transferring students. After discussions the committee approved the actions taken by McDowell.
- ❖ The Committee called from the table of October 7, 2009 on McDowell's request to be released from District Ten Football to join District 7, WPIAL for scheduling purposes. The Committee approved the release to District 7, in Football only.
- ❖ The Committee approved a proposed addition to Article XII Section 1 (Champions and District Qualifiers) Section 1 region play; subsection A to include the following language. *Best record to be defined as the best winning percentage in league play (number of wins divided by the total number of games played) In those sports where ties are possible, any tie is counted as a half win.*

- ❖ Barb Dzuricsko present some concerns of the Athletic Directors organization: All concerns were discussed and continued to the next meeting. They include:
  1. *Assignor communication with schools*
  2. *Cross country invitationals*
  3. *Wrestling Tournaments-dual meet competitions*
  4. *School scheduling survey*
- ❖ The Committee asked the Athletic Directors to submit a report regarding their recommendations at the next scheduled committee meeting.

## BUSINESS AND FINANCE

Mr. Picardo submitted the Treasurer's Report. He prepared a written review of the fall championship financial reports. After all expenditures were paid, a profit of \$28,652.00 was realized. All individual tournament statements can be found on the website. Mr. Picardo also submitted for Committee approval the reimbursement for schools participating in the football tournament. This amount (\$10,276) was approved along with all fall reports. In addition the Treasurers report for December 2<sup>nd</sup> was also approved leaving a balance of \$61,808.82.

Mr. Rafle, Marketing Director, update the Committee on the winter Championships. He indicated that all items have been ordered and will be received in advance of the scheduled events.

Dr. Iacino presented a brief synopsis for the upcoming realignment meeting and future scheduling for the next two-year cycle. Additional information will be coming in the near future.
