The following highlights the District Ten meeting of October 7th 2009

ADMINISTRATION

- ❖ The Committee listened to a presentation by a member school (McDowell High School) involving playing in District Seven for the sport of football. The Committee tabled this request until a later date when school enrollments have been completed. The Committee also ruled ineligible a transfer student to McDowell.
- ❖ The Committee approved the suspension of Boys Soccer by Oil City High School for the remainder of the season.
- ❖ Chairman Blucas reminded all members to inform their representative schools that enrollment data is due by October 15th to the PIAA.
